A Farewell to Friends

Our hearts broke this year as we said goodbye to a pair of Camp friends, **Jim Detterline** and **Susan Kiscadden**.

With deep sadness we share that **Dr. James Detterline**, Camp Conrad Weiser Counselor from 1976-1978, passed away as the apparent victim



of a rock climbing accident. Jim was a Long's Peak Ranger and responsible for approximately 1,200 rescues during his career and had been awarded the Congressional Medal of Valor. He had 428 ascents of 14,259 ft. Long's Peak, the most in history by a single individual. Jim touched the lives of everyone he met. He is survived by his wife, Rebecca, and the Detterline families of Peter, Jon & Nancy, and nephews Scott and Matthew.

If you've called Camp in the past decade, **Susan Kiscadden** was the "voice of camp;" she was the first person a new camp family spoke to, and was often the voice that answered when a nervous parent called to check on their child. Around Camp she was known as Miss Sue, Sue K, or simply Sue. She preferred Sue, but we found it hard to break the habit of calling her Sue K after so many years. She was smart, sarcastic, and beautiful, and she had a wicked sense of humor. She loved to read, and participated in book exchanges. She especially loved spending time at the Jersey Shore with her husband, Clint. Sue loved her cats.



She cherished her family. She was proud of her children and adored her grandchildren. Sue K is missed each and every day. *Keep the Fires Burning.*

Capital Campaign Update

Two of our most exciting projects kicked-off this fall. In September, we drained the ancient steel pool to prepare for new construction featuring slides, climbing walls, diving boards, splash features and a zero-entry design. We anticipate the pool being completed before the end of the year with decking and landscaping seeing completion in the spring.

We began Phase 1 renovations on the Dining Hall this November. In this phase, the kitchen and existing dining areas will be completely renovated, and an outdoor seating area will be added. This phase will be completed by March 31st. Phase 2, which includes the addition of a new wing and restrooms will begin next fall.
