




MOUNTAIN VIEWS - THE VALUE OF CAMP

Why do we send our children into the woods each year for summer camp? For some it's a tradition, for others it's a rite of passage. Last year, I conducted a survey on LinkedIn and asked parents that very question: Why send a child to camp? People responded:

- 1. 48% wanted their child go gain independence
- 2. 31% of respondents hoped their young person increased self-esteem
- 3. 15% sent their children to camp to make new friends
- 4. 5% of parents hoped their campers learned *traditional values*
- 5. 2% of respondents wanted their children to learn *new skills*

Summer Camp at Conrad Weiser or Bynden Wood accomplishes these goals. Campers gain independence and make new friends living with their peers and camp counselors hours away from their families. As young people tackle new challenges in archery, riding, or climbing a tower they learn new skill and gain self-esteem with each accomplishment. Our summer staff teach the YMCA values of caring, honesty, respect and responsibility to everyone we work with. This is the good work we do every day—as we have for more than 60 years. - *Cassie Klein*, Summer Camp and Outdoor Education staff member in 2010, started her new position as Education Specialist the Palm Beach Zoo.


DADDY-DAUGHTER DANCE

As we look forward to a future of serving kids and families from across Berks County and around the world, we must look at protecting the historic nature of our unique summer camp facility. We are fortunate to still be the caretakers of 4 buildings remaining from the Bynden Wood Hotel era (*Bynden Wood Lodge, Terrace Cottage, Roadside Cottage, & Crossroads Cottage*). Additionally we have 1 remaining stone building from the Cameron Estate (the *Caretakers Cottage*), and the foundations of the mansion upon which we have built our high ropes course.

In the coming months, you will be hearing more about an effort to preserve, renovate, and use the historic buildings of the past for the campers and programs of today. Currently, Bynden Wood Lodge in entering the final phase of its renovation process to restore the auditorium and install and new state-of-the-art kitchen.
