On Sunday October 26th camp alum, friends, and family attended a reception at Bynden Wood Lodge during the annual Fall Festival to honor Dr. Jack W. Gruber for his many years of dedicated service to South Mountain YMCA Camps. During the reception Dr. Gruber was presented with the 2014 Service to Youth award.

The Service to Youth Award recognizes commitment and leadership provided by an extraordinary individual that has given their treasure of time, talent, experience and dedication. This individual has directly contributed to and supported the organization, has inspired the launch of new programs or

activities through their efforts, and has encouraged and motivated others to take leadership roles within the organization.

Jack began his career at camp in 1951 as a Junior Counselor. He was a member of the camp staff from 1952 through 1958, in 1957 he was the Associate Director. He served on the Board of Directors from 1969 – 2008, and in 2003 served as Chair of the Capital Campaign. In 2009 Jack was awarded Emeritus status as a Trustee, today he continues to serve in various ways but most importantly as a mentor to us all. We are blessed to know him and fortunate to continue to work with him for the betterment of South Mountain YMCA Camps.
