

International Camper Exchange Program (ICEP) campers will travel, under the capable supervision of a South Mountain YMCA leader, and will participate in a two week International Summer Camp at beautiful YMCA Camp Abbensen for fellowship, activities and international understanding. A one week homestay with a screened and approved YMCA family, as well as a one week tour of Germany to include Berlin, Dresden and Munich are highlights of the experience.
