SOUTH MOUNTAIN YMCA CAMPS Capital Campaign Progress Report

We hope you've had the opportunity to visit Camp this year. So much has changed as we've tackled several large construction projects, but we hope it still feels like home when you visit.

While the new pool was open for the first day of Bynden Wood Day Camp, work continued on the pool straight through the fall. The filter work was completed, the pool basin plastered, and the pool deck concrete was poured by June 1st. Temporary shade structures were erected on the sun deck, now named **Kula Korner**, during the first week of summer camp. The installation of the retention wall (seen in the background of the top-most pool picture), was completed in early July. Soon after, the new fence installation was wrapped up. New lighting for night swims was completed in late July, and the final **Aqua Bright** coating was applied to the pool basin in early October after we had closed the pool for the year.









Anyone who visited us over the summer knows the Dining Hall was the greater of the two construction challenges. While we had the hall itself open for the first day of Camp Conrad Weiser, the project was months behind schedule and the kitchen did not open until mid-July. Our Dining Services team worked out of a kitchen trailer unit for almost 5 weeks this past summer and were thrilled to finally get back in their kitchen space. Many thanks to both the Facilities and Dining Services teams for their hard work and sacrifice. In addition to the kitchen and dining hall renovations, we opened the **Pantano Patio** this summer. This outdoor dining and program space was used extensively this year.
