### THE MOUNTAIN BY MOONLIGHT!

October 11, 12, 18, & 19

We are excited to announce the return of *The Mountain by Moonlight*, our family-friendly Halloween-themed event featuring both haunted and non-haunted hayrides, carnival games, glow-stick zip-lining, glow zorbing, and much more. Our featured event, the Haunted Hayride, is a 25-minute ride through the forest braving zombies, giant spiders, and a variety of ghosts, goblins and ghouls. Our non-haunted wagon ride will take our visitors to Cushion Peak for a beautiful view across Berks County at night.

While gates open at 5:30pm, most attractions open at 6:00pm. Parking is FREE. The Haunted Hayride begins each night at 7:00pm. Our parking gates will close at 9:00pm, but attractions will remain open while there are visitors to participate in them.

Tickets are \$1 each, 12 for \$10, and 25 for \$20. Visitors can purchase tickets at the event, or skip the lines and order them in advance from the Camp Office. For 2019, we will be processing credits cards and accepting cash (no personal checks, please). Please note, there is no ATM on site.
