General Description

This position is directly responsible for overseeing the supervision, program, and care of the equestrian program. Daily responsibilities include: coordination and supervision of barn chores, development and delivery of creative Equestrian programming, development and implementation of specialty equestrian programs (community lessons, trail rides, etc.), and being a positive part of the overall summer camp team. This position is responsible to ensure the development, confidence, and personal growth in working with horses, campers, and lesson design.

Qualifications

- Minimum 21 years of age.
- Previous supervisory experience preferred.
- Ability to work long hours, including evenings.
- Ability to develop positive relationships with campers and fellow staff.
- Possess strong communication skills and group facilitation.
- Be able to multi- task and handle a fast-paced environment.
- A basic understanding of children/teens and the ability to develop positive relationships with them.
- Experience and desire to work with children.
- Committed to being a part of the Equestrian team.
- Past experience with horses and animal husbandry.
- Independent work ethic and a strong sense of humor.
- Logistical ability required.
- Strong/demonstrated skill in English style riding.
- A clean US Driver's License is desirable.
- Minimum first aid and CPR certification required

- Create a safe and fun environment for campers with the camp horses.
- Design week long curriculum for educational activity sessions.
- Contribute to daily chore routine for campers and staff.
